ALGORITHMS - RULES

Participation Guidelines:

- Each team consists of 2-3 members.
- Do not open question booklet until asked.
- If you leave the room, you cannot return.
- Participants are not allowed to collaborate with anyone else other than his/her team members during the contest.
- Single round competition, top team will be declared winner.
- Use of internet is strictly prohibited.
- Use of cellphones, calculators or any other electronic device is strictly prohibited. If anybody is found using one, their whole team will be disqualified.
- Participants cannot bring any notebook or writing pad to the contest room.

Competition Guidelines:

- Blank sheets of paper and pens will be provided to each team.
- Please write your team names on top of each sheet to be submitted.
- Judgment will be made on the basis of:
 - Correctness of algorithms
 - Time and space complexity of algorithms (Remember that binary search is better than linear search)
- At times, you might have to create your own algorithm. At other times, you may need to refer to the most famous algorithms.
- Do not fear to use the famous algorithms. Applying them to your problem, keeping in mind their complexities may be considered a plus.
- You may use mathematical or C style pseudo code. Compliance to a particular programming language is not necessary.
- Use of library functions of any particular language and API's is highly discouraged.
- The decision of judge will stand unchallenged.
- Your team shall be disqualified, if found using any unfair means during the contest.
- Failing to observe any of the above rules may lead to deduction in points or direct disqualification from the contest.
