## Participation Guidelines:

- Each team consists of 1-3 members.
- Do not open question booklet until asked.
- If you leave the room, you cannot return.
- Participants are not allowed to collaborate with anyone else other than his/her team members.
- Single round competition, top team will be declared winner.
- Use of Internet, cellphones, calculators or any other electronic device is strictly prohibited. If anybody is found using one, their whole team will be disqualified.
- Participants must report 30 minutes before the start of competition. No extra time would be provided.
- Do not make any irrelevant noise during the contest. Just raise your hand and volunteers will entertain your problems.
- Participants cannot bring any manual, notebook or writing pad to the contest room.
- Blank sheets of paper and pens will be provided to each teams.

## Competition Guidelines:

• Programs would be given in C/C++ language. Modifications must be done in the same language. Pseudo codes are not acceptable and may lead to negative marking.

## Additional Guidelines:

- Your answers will be checked by a group of experts.
- The decision of judges will stand unchallenged.
- Your team can be dis-qualified, if found using any unfair means.
- Failing to observe any of the above rules may lead to deduction in points or direct disqualification from the contest.
